Drop off and Pick Up?

Dress Code

What To Bring!

You are going away for 5 days. Have enough clothes for being away that long. Keep in mind majority of our time we will be outside even at night. It could be hot during the day and very cold in the evenings/night. We will be doing physical and messy activities every day as well campfires and chapels. There is a pool. Be prepared to have clothes for all these activities.

Basics: Sun Screen, Shower Towel, Pool Towel, Jacket/Sweater, Bathing suit, Bible, a Pen, Pillow, Sheets for bed, Blanket(s) or sleeping bag for bedding, Toiletries: toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, soap, shampoo, Chapstick.

Prices & Extras
